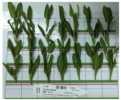

- From stock plant to shipping, your UIC are handled with care at every step of the way.
- Cuttings are bagged and brought to cooler to begin the cold chain within 8-20 minutes from harvest. Bags are collected from each greenhouse cooler frequently and brought to one of the temperature-controlled coolers, where each tray is stored at its optimal temperature.
- Danziger's quality control standards are top-of-the-line, checking up to 25% of cuttings prior to shipping. From a peak season a minimum of 6% of cuttings are checked in their dedicated, climate-controlled coolers that the rest of the plants are never taken.
- Every tray has a barcode that can trace cuttings back to the harvest, greenhouse bench, and harvest time. These barcodes are scanned at each step of production to ensure that you get exactly what you ordered throughout the process.
- Even before you order, Danziger's staff in Guatemala is doing everything they can to provide live availability by refreshing each bench weekly so they can update the availability, always striving to 90 orders. We almost never have plants available to harvest when we ordered them and beyond their planted availability, guaranteeing you an answer within 48 hours of ordering.
